## Weekly News - Week 2

Hello,

Well Done to all the children who have already completed the Premier's Reading Challenge. Our goal is for the whole class to complete the challenge. Please come and see me if you need another form to complete.

### Spelling

We will be looking at the 'ck' sound, ck follows a single short vowel when it comes at the end or the middle of a word. For example, truck, black, pocket.

Tricky words: my & they.

### Maths

This week in Maths the children will be focusing on backward counting across the decade and subtraction. Questions you could ask your child; eg what number comes before 120? Before 80? Before 40? etc. encouraging them to use their fist to assist their counting.

They will also be exploring Fractions, focusing on halves and quarters.

### Daily 5

This week the children will be looking for interesting words in their reading and recording these words down. The children will learn that good readers use interesting words in their speaking and writing. When your child reads to you encourage them to point out interesting words as they read. We will refer to these words as 'WOW' words.
