Hello,

The children have settled very well into Term 4 and have been busy preparing for Grandparents Day next week.

Spelling

Week 2 - oy

This week we will focus on 'oy' spelling.

Jolly Phonics Action: Cup hands around mouth and shout as if to another boat, oi, ship ahoy!

Spelling Rules oi and oy in one syllable words.

Week 1: Use oi in the middle of a word e.g. choice, boil.

Week 2: Use oy a the end of a word e.g. boy, toy.

Spelling Rules oi and oy in longer words

Week 1:Use oi in the middle of a syllable e.g. moisture, poisonous.

Week 2: Use oy at the end of a word of before a vowel e.g. loyal, destroy.

Tricky words — when and where

Maths

This week in Mathematics we will be focusing on Number and Algebra. This will include locating numbers on a hundred chart and giving the before and after of a given number.

The children will be focusing on Australian coins. We will be learning to make different combinations of money amounts and learning to exchange money for goods in play situations and give correct change.
