Spelling -Week 4- th
There are two ways to pronounce the 'th' sound. 'Th' is more strongly pronounced in some words- thought, think. 'Th' is less emphasised in some words- this, they, that.
While pronunciation is different, the spelling for 'th' is always made with the letters 'th'.
Your child 's weekly spelling list will be stuck into their school diaries each week. Please sign this once you have sighted it. Please remind your child to revise their words during the week. Tricky words this week are; she and we. Ideas for practising words- writing with chalk, writing on a whiteboard, typing on the computer or encouraging your child to write words in sentences.

Maths
This week in Mathematics the children will be working with hundreds charts. The children will be learning where numbers are located on a 100 s chart. We will continue counting in 2 s , 5 s and 10 s from different starting points. The children will continue to explore 2D shape focussing on correct names and attributes of these shapes.

An oral counting assessment was also sent home in your child's test book on Friday. Please revise any errors with your child. Repetition of counting forwards and backwards from different starting points is recommended. You can support your child by encouraging forwards and backwards counting from different starting points. Questions you could ask your child; 'What number comes before 13?' 'What number comes after 49?' Please ensure your child is pronouncing the teen numbers properly.

The Premier's Reading Challenge is a literacy engagement program that was introduced to: Encourage students to read more books and enjoy reading \& Improve literacy levels.
The Challenge requires students to read 12 books between the beginning of the school year and early September from the very wide booklist.
A Premiers Reading Challenge form was sent home for you to keep a record of the books your child is reading. The children are encouraged to borrow Premiers Reading Challenge books (books with orange stickers) from our weekly Library lessons. We are aiming for the whole class to participate in this challenge.
