#### **Spelling**

<u>Week 4: a\_e</u> (the \_ indicates a missing consonant - a letter that is not a vowel)

Name - the letter 'e' jumps over the consonant (the letter m) and makes the 'a' turn into a long vowel (AY). The magic 'e' has then done its job and remains silent - you cannot hear it when you pronounce the word.

Tricky words: down & does

This week in Mathematics children will be learning how to gather data, use tally marks and interpret the data that they have collected.
