Spelling Week 4 – y as a vowel– making a long i sound

The main ways of writing the long i sound are; ie, i_e, igh and y. Last week we looked at the igh sound, and this week we are focusing on the 'y' spelling. When y comes at the end of a word it can make a long e or long i sound. An 'i' never comes at the end of a word—we say the 'i' is too shy and that 'tough y' comes to the rescue. For example by, my, try.
