### Spelling - Week 5 - er, 6 - ir and 7- ur

Weeks 5, 6 and 7 are dedicated to learning the 'er' sound which can be written as er – herb, ir-dirt and ur-hurt.

The 'er' sound is challenging because there are no rules to help decide which spelling to use. Once your child knows the different spellings that make the 'er' sound they will need to rely on their visual memory and choose the one that 'looks' right.

### <u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths the children will be looking early multiplication and division. We will also be looking at outcomes of familiar events involving chance and describe them using everyday language such as 'will happen', 'won't happen' or 'might happen'.

### Swimming Week

Swimming week begins next week (Week 6: 20th – 24th November). Please ensure your children bring the following named items in a separate bag every day: towel, bathers, goggles, change of underwear (if needed) and Asthma puffer (if required). Please make sure that all these items as well as clothing and shoes are <u>clearly</u> <u>labelled with your child's name</u>.

Our class swimming time will be at **11:50am**. We will aim to be at the pool 10 minutes prior to our lesson to get changed.

Children are able to wear their PE uniform all of this week. However if its easier to send girls in their summer uniform dresses, that is okay too.

On Tuesday 21st November (next week, week 6) both Year 1 classes will be performing our 'A-Z of Christmas' Assembly at STARplex Theatre at 9.40am.
