Spelling Week 6-ew

Ew can be made as ew, u_e, ue. This week we are focusing on the **ew** spelling. The 'ew' sound can be pronounced as 'oo' for example new or as a 'ue' sound for example 'grew'.

This weeks tricky words are; father & mother.

Maths

This week in Maths children will be looking at **time**. They will be describing the duration of time using months, weeks, days and hours.

Please revise over with your child the order of the days of the week and months of the year. We are learning to relate days and months to events in own life. We are learning that months are connected with seasons.

We will also be making o'clock and half past times on analogue and digital clocks.
