Spelling Week 7 - ou

Ou can be made as ou or ow. This week we are focusing on the <u>ou</u> spelling. Ou is commonly used at the start and middle of a word.

Examples: out, mouse, house.

<u>Jolly Phonics Action</u>: Pretend your middle finger is a neddle and prick your thumb and say "ou, ou, ou".

This weeks tricky words are: any & many.

Maths

This week in Maths children will continue focusing on **time**. We will be learning about o'clock and half past times on both analogue and digital clocks.

They will be describing the duration of time using months, weeks, days and hours.

Please continue to revise with your child the order of the days of the week and months of the year. We are learning to relate days and months to events in

own life. We are learning that months are connected

with seasons.
