Spelling

For Spelling this week we are focusing on the '<u>ar</u>' sound. The letter <u>r</u> in 'ar' often overpowers the vowel making it unable to be heard. For example c<u>ar</u>, st<u>ar</u>, f<u>ar</u> all have a strong <u>r</u>sound. Encourage your child to remember that two letters can often make one sound. When they hear the 'r' sound they need to remember it is made with the letters 'ar'.

We will be revising Tricky Words this week; he and she.

<u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths children will continue to focus on skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s from different starting points.

We will also be focusing on money. Children will be identifying coin values and ordering them based on their value.
