Spelling – ff

We will be learning about the doubling rule.

Doubling Rule: 'f's' are doubled when they are at the end of a word and follow a short vowel.

For example; fluff, sniff, cliff, etc.

Tricky Words: have & like.

Reading

Daily 5 - The children have been learning about the fluency strategy 'Scoops the Pelican'. This is where the children focus on reading smoothly and work on not reading robotically. We are encouraging the children to add expression to their voices when reading. The children have also learnt the strategy 'Bob the Bat', which is to back up and re-read when something doesn't make sense. It has been very rewarding to hear the children "backing up" and re-reading and observing their pride in applying this skill.

Last week, each child received a book mark with some of the strategies we have been using and some that we will learn about during the year.

Maths

This week in maths we will be focusing on simple addition problems. We will revise the strategies we have learnt and put them into practise.

We will also continue to explore money. We will focus on learning the names, size, features and appearance of Australian coins and their value.

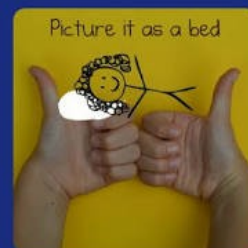
